

A panoramic radiograph or Panorex is a panoramic scanning dental X-ray of the upper and lower jaw. It shows a two-dimensional view of a half-circle from ear to ear. This is done during your Quality Control or QC appointment and takes about 30-45 minutes.

Our goals during this QC appointment are to:

- Identify any tooth that can be improved and reposition the associated bracket;
- Fit for the last set of wires and take photographs of your in-process smile;
- Predict approximately how much longer you will be wearing your braces.

After your QC appointment, you may want to eat soft foods for two to three days. Tylenol or Motrin can be taken to relieve any minor discomfort.
